# ABOUT THE SERVICE

Studio Mira Essential+ is a service intended for projects where the floor plan has been decided on and architectural drawings are available.

The essential+ service includes to scale concept joinery design and drawings. This service allows for up to 1 revision. Any further revisions will be billed at an hourly fee of \$175.

This service is suitable for renovations and new-builds.

It consists of 1 in person session of up to 3 hours to create a detailed brief.

1 follow up session of up to 2 hours to present drawings and note any revisions.

# ESSENTIALS

## WHAT TO EXPECT

01

### Before

Before your first session, be sure to know what your timeline and budget are, and email through any relevant information (such as design drawings, inspirational images, images of the existing space etc.)

02

### During

You get two sessions during which we work out your specific joinery needs.

Session 1:

In the first session we will develop the design direction, create a strong concept and sketch out a joinery plan.

In between sessions:

Designer will draw up all joinery details, including elevations and details.

Session 2:

During the second session we will return with the drawings, and go through all the plans together with you. We will make note of any necessary changes.

### After

After Session 2 you will receive an email containing full detail joinery drawings in a PDF format including any changes discussed during the session.

What is the cost of the Essential Drawing Service?

All drawings are priced at \$250/sqm or \$500/m

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When will you send the invoice?

The invoice for the consult will be emailed together with your welcome packet and must be paid for prior to session 1.

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Will you liaise with my trades?

The Essentials+ is a drawing service only. We will not liaise with trades but are happy to provide them with the .cad files.

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
